

Chameleon Pigment

These pigment powders change color depending on the angle of the light.

To work properly they need to be applied to a dark surface such as black, royal blue, dark red or similar.

There are several ways of doing this, if working with 2 part epoxy in a silicone mold you can simply use a brush or foam applicator (like for makeup) to brush the pigment into the mold, Make sure to completely coat the inside of the mold so the rubber is not visible and then pour in your epoxy. When the epoxy is cured simply remove the finished part from the mold and you will see the surface is coated with the pigment and is permeant.

Another method that can be used is to mix the pigment into some clear coat such as paint or nail polish, then apply that to any finished surface. Once dried you will see the effect.
